**Action**

- The Eco Team met to look at the finalise the Eco Magazine and make final adjustments before so that it is ready to be sent on the Website/App.

- The Eco Committee spoke about the bins. They stated that the bins are still not being used properly and the wrong items are placed in the wrong bins which means that all the rubbish then has to go in the 'normal' waste bin.
