- Headscarves must be plain and either navy blue, white or black.
- In summer, girls may wear blue school dresses. Boys may wear white polo shirts, but with a tie.
- In warm weather, children will need a sunhat.
- In cold weather, children will need a warm coat, hat and gloves. We go outside every day, whatever the weather.
- Please note that only sensible, black, flat shoes are allowed. High heels, boots, strappy sandals and flip flops are not permitted.
- PE kits must be brought to school on Monday and left at school all week. PE kits must be taken home on Friday for washing. If your child does not bring their PE kit to school a letter will be sent home. It is strongly advised that children wear tracksuit bottoms for winter games.

- Jewellery is limited to a small wrist watch and plain studded earrings. If a child is wearing more jewellery than permitted, they will be asked to remove it and it will be returned to them at the end of the school day.
- Children's hair must be worn in an appropriate style with no extreme styling or designs. Mohicans/lines/patterns or shaven heads are not permitted. Pupils with long hair will be required to tie their hair back. Hair accessories must be Navy, blue, grey or white are worn for practical reasons rather than for fashion purposes.

The role of the school

The school will ensure that the cost of the school uniform is affordable ensuring that branded items are kept to a minimum.

The school will ensure that all parents are aware of the school uniform requirements stating clearly what is optional and what is required. The school uniform will published on the school website.

The school will ensure that that our suppliers provide high quality items and are value for money.

The school will endeavour to make second-hand uniform available to acquire.

The role of parents

We ask all parents who send their children to our school to support the school uniform policy. We believe that parents have a duty to send their children to school correctly dressed and ready for their daily schoolwork. One of the responsibilities of parents is to ensure that their child has the correct uniform, and that it is clean and in good repair.

If any parent would like the school to modify the uniform policy, they should make representation, in the first instance, to the Principal. The school welcomes children from all backgrounds and faith communities. If there are serious reasons, for example on religious grounds, why parents may want their child to wear clothes that differ from the school uniform, the school will sensitively consider such requests.

The role of governors

The governing body supports the Principal in implementing the school uniform policy. It considers all representations from parents regarding the uniform policy and liaises with the Principal to ensure that the policy is implemented fairly and with sensitivity.

It is the governors' responsibility to ensure that the school uniform meets all regulations concerning equal opportunities.

Governors ensure that the school uniform policy helps children to dress sensibly, in clothing that are hardwearing, safe and practical.
